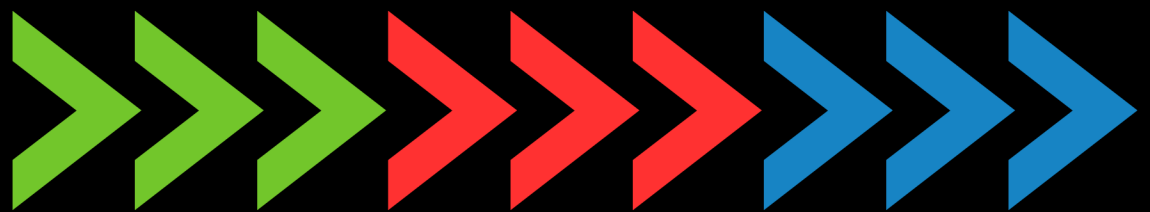

CHILD SAFETY

Statement of commitment to child safety

All children who are a part of 3d Arts Company have a right to feel and be safe. The welfare of children in our care will always be our first priority and we have zero tolerance of child abuse. We aim to create a child safe and child friendly environment where children feel safe and have fun. A copy of our Child Safe Policy can be found on our website, plus our Code of Conduct, reporting & complaints procedures.

Feeling Unwell

Students who are unwell should not attend class. If a student becomes unwell during 3d Arts class we may get in touch and ask that they are collected. Please ensure your contact details are always current.

First Aid

We have a qualified first aid person at each site at all times. If you require first aid when at 3d Arts please see one of the 3d Arts team. Students with asthma or anaphylaxis must provide their asthma or anaphylaxis plan to 3d Arts before classes commence. Students requiring an EpiPen are also required to have it on them at 3d classes and performances and notify their teacher and host of it's location.

Sign In

All students arriving at classes must sign in with our Host each week. Junior Academy students must be signed in by a parent/guardian. Youth and adult students may sign themselves in.

Student Drop-off

Students should arrive just before the commencement of their class time and be picked up at their finishing time. Please sign out when students are picked up, we cannot allow Junior Academy students to leave unaccompanied. Please make every effort to be present at pick up time. Class Manager Portal & BAND

Our Class Manager Portal / BAND & email are our primary modes of communication. For Class Manager sign in via the link sent to your inbox. Please use your email address and create a password if you haven't already. The Class Manger Portal will list your child's classes, upcoming events and dates, notifications, invoicing and other important info.

We also use the app BAND for our Youth classes. Details will be sent once classes start for BAND.

HOUSEKEEPING

Uniform

At 3d Arts, students are not required to wear specialised uniforms for classes, however we encourage students to purchase their own black 3d Arts T-shirt. Our new 3d Arts t-shirts will be available for \$32 (including GST) We also have hoodies available! Cost TBC. From time to time, we will also offer optional production t-shirts based on demand.

Students are also encouraged to wear clothing and footwear that is suitable to move in for all classes - no jeans, skirts or thongs/sandals. For dance classes please wear appropriate dance attire. From time to time we also take promotional photos during classes. For the sake of student privacy, we therefore recommend that students do not wear their school uniform to class.

Food & Drink

We ask that Junior Academy students bring their own afternoon tea snack as well as a water bottle. Junior students will be given an opportunity to have a snack between their classes. Please note that as we have students with nut allergies & anaphylaxis. 3d Arts is a nut free environment.

Absences

Students are expected to show a high commitment to weekly classes. Parents should notify us via email and in advance where possible if students are unable to attend class. Due to the high demand on class places, we may need to discuss making your place available to those on our waiting list if absences are prolonged. Refunds for student absences are not available.



FEES & FINANCE



As a not-for-profit, registered charity with the ACNC, we have a vision to provide access to the Arts to all people, we have a heart to ensure that money matters don't prevent anyone from participating.

Whilst financial pressures have increased over the last few years resulting in fee increases, we do not want anyone to miss out because of financial pressures. We believe 3d Arts still remains more affordable than similar programs.

Production Levy

Production levies help towards covering the significant additional costs of costuming, licencing & royalties, venue costs, technical & sound equipment, set construction, consumables & resources (e.g. scripts, make-up) and staffing costs for additional rehearsals. All classes that do a production will incur a production levy.

Junior Academy students will incur a production levy of \$67.50 per student (\$35 invoiced in term 2 and \$32.50 in term 3)

Senior Academy students will incur a production levy of \$90 per enrolled class (\$45 in either terms 1, 2 or 3 depending on class enrolled in, see fee table below)
